The College of Education at the University of Kentucky is seeking candidates for the following tenure-track faculty position, effective August 15, 2010. Appointments are contingent upon funding, and salaries are commensurate with qualifications and experience. Application reviews will begin November 20, and will continue until position is filled.

Elementary/Middle School Mathematics Education: Assistant professor. Individual will teach elementary/middle school mathematics education courses at undergraduate and graduate levels; conduct research in mathematics education resulting in refereed presentations and publications at the national level; collaborate with mathematics and mathematics education faculty to seek extramural funding for research, development, and teacher enhancement activities; assist in development and teaching of new courses for undergraduate and graduate programs; advise undergraduate and graduate mathematics education students; and provide service to the community, area schools, institution, and professional organizations.

Qualifications: Minimum qualifications include an earned doctorate in mathematics education or related area by August 2010, strong concentration of undergraduate and graduate course work in mathematics and mathematics education, mathematics teaching experience at the K-12 level, and evidence of professional scholarly experience (including national refereed publications and/or presentations) supporting the case for future success in carrying out and directing research in mathematics education. Preference will be given to those candidates who have experience working with historically underrepresented youth and experience teaching at the elementary/middle level.
