The University Counseling Center at the University of Maryland seeks applications for full-time staff position in the Learning Assistance Service as the Math Learning Specialist.

The position coordinates the Math Learning Program which includes working with undergraduate and graduate students individually, in groups and/or in classes. The position assists students in building self-confidence in math, reducing math anxiety, diagnosing math deficiencies, and developing other strategies designed to help students be successful in required mathematics courses. The position is expected to supervise graduate assistants, consult with faculty and academic departments on math learning skills, conduct research on the impact of interventions, and collaborate with the Math Department including teaching math learning courses.

Applicants should hold a Doctorate in Math Education, Mathematics and/or related disciplines and experience in college level teaching is preferred. Applicants should be available to start on or before July 1, 2010.
