Description of Awards

The Board of Directors of the Association of Mathematics Teacher Educators has established two awards to be given annually to two mathematics teacher educators of national recognition at the Annual Meeting of the AMTE. The purpose of these awards is to recognize excellence in each area of mathematics teacher education (teaching, service, research).

The purpose of the first award, the **Excellence Award in Mathematics Teacher Education**, rotates every three years, focusing on a different area: **Excellence in Teaching**; **Nadine Bezuk Excellence in Leadership and Service**; and **Excellence in Scholarship**.

The second award, the **Early Career Award**, recognizes a mathematics teacher educator who, while early in his/her career, has made distinguished contributions and shows exceptional potential for leadership in these areas.
