- Degree in Education or a related field. The ideal candidate will have knowledge of Singapore Math and experience with a concept-led mathematics curriculum.
- Demonstrated knowledge of intervention methodologies and experience as a math teacher and/or learning specialist
- Strong understanding of children's developmental, intellectual, and social and emotional needs
- Proven ability to work collaboratively with students, parents, faculty, and administration and capacity move toward solutions through professional dialogue
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Strong Interpersonal skills with an ability to problem solve and build consensus.
